By registering with My History Tutor you are confirming that you agree to these Terms so please take the time to read and understand them.

REGISTRATION

Clients are required to provide adequate contact details including:

- Email addresses of the student and parent/carer.
- Landline and/or mobile numbers.
- Any changes to contact details during the period of tuition.

PAYMENT

- A free 20 minute consultation is available on request for the student and parent/carer to meet the tutor, ask any questions and view how online tuition works.
- Charges (subject to review at the end of October 2024):
 - KS3 Lessons are charged at £40 per hour.
 - GCSE Lessons are charged at £45 per hour.
 - A Level Lessons are charged at £50 per hour.
- Clients may request an **initial paid trial lesson** before arranging regular tuition lessons.
- Invoices will be emailed either on the day of the tuition session or 4-weekly basis as agreed by the client and My History Tutor.
- Cancellation of a lesson: If you cancel a lesson with less than 24 hours' notice, a £20 cancellation fee will be charged (except for where there is a death in the family).
- **Non-payment of fees:** My History Tutor reserves the right to refuse to allow the student to attend tuition while fees remain unpaid or if there is a persistent failure for fees to be paid on time.

Payment for 1:1 Online Tuition

- Payments are via Bank Transfer within **24 hours of** the lesson taking place.
- Blocks of Lessons can also be paid for in advance.

Payment for Group Tuition

- Minimum numbers are required for group tuition.
- Fees for group lessons must be paid in advance and are non-refundable due to the nature of group tuition.

LESSONS

- Lessons are for the duration of 1 hour; however bespoke lesson lengths are available upon request.
- Lessons will always take place on the day and time specified in the email that accompanies these terms and conditions, unless a change is agreed in advance.
- Lessons are conducted on Google Meets.
- For 1:1 lessons, the student will be given a unique and individual Google Meets link.
- The lesson resources will be shared prior to the lesson beginning via Google Docs using the student's email address.
- Lessons take place during term time, unless otherwise arranged and agreed upon between the client and the Tutor.

Safeguarding

- Parent/s or guardian/s must be present at the venue within earshot for all lessons and are welcome to come into lessons at any time.
- Online tuition lessons should take place in an open room such as the dining room, kitchen or living room, with the door open. If this is not possible, please ensure the environment is appropriate.
- Students should be appropriately dressed for the lessons (i.e. not in nightwear, beach wear etc).

Punctuality

- Clients are responsible for logging in for online tuition on time.
- Lessons will begin at the scheduled time.
- If a student is late, the time will not be made up (i.e. the lesson time will not be extended) and the lesson will end at the pre-arranged time.
- If for any reason the Tutor is late, the full 60 minutes lesson will take place if possible (i.e. if there isn't a scheduled lesson due to start with another client) or the time will be added to the next tuition lesson.

Tutor Obligations

- Agrees to prepare all materials prior to lessons and to structure lessons in such a way to optimise learning time.
- Agrees to keep personal details of the students, including names and pictures
 of students' faces strictly confidential in the case of using lesson materials or
 screenshots for the purpose of marketing on social media.
- Shall at no time be required or obligated to complete students' homework or assignments.

Student Obligations

- Agrees to login for online lessons on time for the start of their lesson.
- Agrees to have their webcam turned on (unless otherwise agreed).
- Agrees to participate fully in the lessons to the best of their ability.
- Agrees that tasks, exercises or homework will be completed.

- Agrees to ensure that all equipment (computer/laptop/iPad, graphic tablets/apple pencils, webcams, headphones and microphones) are ready and charged before the lesson starts.
- Agrees that mobile phones and social media will not be used and will be muted during the lesson unless the tutor has asked the student to do so for learning purposes.
- Agrees to use appropriate and respectful language.

LESSON CANCELLATION

- Contracts can be cancelled by both sides at any time. My History Tutor will endeavour to give 2 weeks' notice prior to cancellation as a courtesy.
- To cancel a scheduled lesson, please give at least 24 hours' notice in advance.
- If a cancellation is made with more than 24 hours' notice, an alternative time and day will be offered that is mutually convenient to both the tutor and student.
- If you cancel a lesson without 24 hours' notice, a £20 cancellation fee will be charged for the loss of earnings/lesson planning (except where there has been a death in the family).
- Any lessons cancelled by My History Tutor for any reason, will be:
 - o rescheduled where possible, or
 - o refunded in full if the client has pre-paid by deducting the cost of the lesson from your next invoice.
- Repeated Cancellations: My History Tutor reserves the right to withdraw tuition for repeated cancellations and/or no shows.

STUDENT PROGRESS

- It is the parents' responsibility to provide any additional information they feel is important to tuition (for example medical conditions/special education needs etc.)
- Parents are welcome to join the video call at the beginning or end of the lesson for feedback.
- Written reports will not be provided.
